Setting up

- Give the oath to alternate Judge and Clerks
- Set up the Controller and power on Controller and DUOs
- Power on the Scanner
- Set up and power on the pollpads
- Make sure the DUO Go is plugged in and charging
- Set out and organize all paperwork
- Put out the distance markers
- Postings and maps
- Fill out time sheets

Open the Polls



OPENING THE POLLS

OPENING CONTROLLER ON ELECTION DAY:

1. After the **CONTROLLER** has been connected to the string of **TOUCH** voting machines. Connect the power cord to the **CONTROLLER** and the wall. This will allow the **CONTROLLER** to run off the electrical outlet and not the battery
2. Select "**PRINT ZERO REPORT**" Assign booths by going to each booth and pressing. Booth Numbers in order. Continue until all booths have been assigned.
3. At the **CONTROLLER** select "**OPEN THE POLLS**".
4. Enter the **OPEN POLLS CODE**, and then select **ACCEPT**. The open polls report will print.
5. Look at the bottom of the **CONTROLLER** screen and make sure the **BALLOT** count is "0" zero. If it is not, **STOP** and call for assistance. If it is "0", enter the number on the Reconciliation Log.
6. **POLLS ARE NOW OPEN.**
7. After the tape is finished printing, tear it off the Controller, sign the bottom of the tape and place it in the **RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE** to be turned in at the end of the night.
8. Now you are ready to start voting at 7:00am.

OPENING SCANNER ON ELECTION DAY:

1. Turn on **SCANNER** (red button on back)
2. Print and tear off **ZERO REPORT**
3. Select "**SCAN OPEN POLLS**" then enter open polls password then select Accept
4. Tear off and place your "**SCAN OPEN POLLS REPORT AND ZERO REPORT**" in the **RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE**
5. Ballot Scanner is now ready to accept ballots

VOTING ORDER PRIORITY

NOTICE OF VOTING ORDER PRIORITY FOR VOTERS WITH CERTAIN DISABILITIES

Pursuant to Section 63.0015, Texas Election Code:

An election officer **shall give voting order priority to individuals with a mobility problem** that substantially impairs the person's ability to move around.

- A person assisting an individual with a mobility problem may also, at the individual's request, be given voting order priority.
- Disabilities and conditions that may qualify you for voting order priority include paralysis, lung disease, the use of portable oxygen, cardiac deficiency, severe limitation in the ability to walk due to arthritic, neurological, or orthopedic condition, wheelchair confinement, arthritis, foot disorder, the inability to walk 200 feet without stopping to rest, or use of a brace, cane, crutch, or other assistive device.
- Voters who wish to be given voting order priority, and be accepted for voting before others in line to vote at that polling place, may indicate this to any election officer serving at the polling place. The presiding election judge shall bring the voter and the voter's assistant, if applicable, forward to the front of the line.

Pollwatcher

- Pollwatcher must have a Certificate of Appointment of Pollwatcher form AND a Certificate of Completion for training
- Read the Affidavit to the watcher, have the watcher sign the Oath, then sign and date the Oath
- Watcher can come at any time
- Watcher may not talk to any voter nor wear any political advertisement (TEC 33.058)
- Watcher can take notes (TEC 33.056)
- Watcher MUST turn off their cell phone (TEC 33.051 (c))





CLOSING POLLS

CLOSING THE POLLS ON CONTROLLER ELECTION DAY:

1. **DO NOT** close the polls until all voters who were in line at 7:00pm have completed voting.
2. Once everyone is finished voting, go to the **CONTROLLER**, select **MENU** at the top of the screen. Select **"CLOSE POLLS"**.
3. The **CONTROLLER** will give you a warning and ask you to confirm that you want to close the poll, select **"YES, CLOSE POLLS"**.
4. Enter the **CLOSE POLLS** password and select **"ACCEPT"**. The close report will print automatically. Tear off reports. Use the **ACCESS CODE SUMMARY & BALLOT COUNT REPORT** to get your end of day totals and enter those totals on the **RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE** and place reports in main envelope.
5. NEXT "The Polls are Closed" screen **CONTROLLER SCREEN RE-PRINT ACCESS CODE SUMMARY & BALLOT COUNT AND LEAVE IT ON CONTROLLER... DO NOT TEAR IT OFF.**
6. Now you can close and **SEAL** your controller.

CLOSING POLL ON SCANNER ELECTION DAY:

1. Press **BLUE** poll worker button on the back of the scanner.
2. Select **"CLOSE POLL"**. will give you a warning and ask you to confirm that you want to close the poll, select **"YES, CLOSE POLL"**.
3. Enter **CLOSE POLL** password
4. Tear off **"TALLY SUMMARY REPORT"** PLACE IN RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE
5. Select **"PRINT BALLOT COUNT"** AND LEAVE ON SCANNER DO NOT TEAR IT OFF.
6. ****PLACE RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE, EQUIPMENT LOG AND BALLOT & SEAL LOG INSIDE SCANNER. NOW YOU MAY CLOSE AND SEAL YOUR SCANNER. *****

At the end of the night the **RECONCILIATION LOG -MAIN ENVELOPE** should contain the Controller and Scanner Zero Tape from the beginning of the day, any cancelled booth access codes, and the Access Code Report from your Controller and Ballot Count Summary Report from your scanner.
